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1. Introduction to PSEB

Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) is an entity under the Ministry of IT & Telecom mandated to act as one stop shop on behalf of Government of Pakistan and ensuring of sustainable growth, development of the industry and enhancing of IT & ITeS exports. One of the objectives of PSEB is availability of skilled resource equipped with technologies for the IT Industry. In order to help increase the employability and to fill the supply gap for industry-ready skilled resource, PSEB under the guidance of Ministry of IT and consultation with IT Industry is initiating a series of HR development program, one of the said programs is equipping of the IT professionals and ICT & Non-ICT graduates with latest technologies by the ICT Industry Professionals which will help in enhancing the number and quality of HR workforce available to Pakistan IT & ITeS industry. Through its various support aims to help Pakistani ΙT companies programs, PSEB and professionals obtain a greater share of the global IT and ITeS marketplace.

2. Overview of the Program

The objective of the program to equip IT professionals and ICT & Non-ICT graduates by providing latest IT industry skills required to fill the shortage of skilled resources. For the purpose, PSEB invites international and local bodies who are willing to provide latest technology training and/or certification program either online/on-site or hybrid at highly discounted prices Furthermore, it will be highly appreciated if free trainings and certification offers are also included. Candidates/trainees from any city of Pakistan can participate in any of the training/certification of their interest, subject to meeting the pre-requisites.

3. Requirements

PSEB desires to pre-qualify principal training & certification providers for the provisioning of Fields of specialized technology training & certifications on special subsidized rates or free of cost (if any) for the growth of IT/BPO sector in Pakistan. The companies





are requested to submit following mandatory documents for the evaluation/selection and to enter into a Framework Agreement with PSEB. 5. Disqualifications

- e. Any other major discrepancy is found in the proposal and/or non-compliance of the terms and conditions of the tors.
- f. The firm/bidder is blacklisted by any of the government entity.

6. General Terms and Conditions:

- a. PSEB reserves the right to accept or reject all or any application as per PPRA rule # 33.
- b. Verification of bidder's customers and their feedback will be a part of ToR evaluation and will be bidders' responsibilities to provide proof, if demanded by the PSEB
- c. The selected companies shall sign a Framework Agreement with PSEB to offer the services.
- d. The trainings indicated under Annexure-II may not be considered for this phase of the program since the same are already being offered under Phase-I.





e. PSEB has rights to pick and choose the proposed trainings.

7. Proposal Submission

The proposal should be submitted in a sealed envelope and marked as "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL FOR PROVISIONING OF TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION THROUGH FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT WITH PSEB." Bidders are to make sure that the financial proposal is **not** part of the technical proposal in any form. The bidders who qualify the technical evaluation will be intimate separately to submit financial proposal.
