# **PSEB PROJECT UPDATES**SKILLS & CAPACITY BUILDING

#### Establishment of 25 STPs in Pakistan with Rental Subsidy Phase-1

PSEB established 25 Software Technology Parks (STPs) in major, secondary, and tertiary cities and towns of Pakistan. These STPs were created by converting public and private-owned dilapidated or defunct office buildings, factories, and warehouses into IT-enabled office spaces, providing affordable rental options for IT & ITeS companies.

These projects collectively represent significant strides in upskilling the IT workforce and building the capacity of IT companies in Pakistan, contributing to the nation's economic growth and global competitiveness.

#### INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

PSEB placed roughly 2,700 interns in Pakistan's IT companies, achieving a 70% retention rate. This program provided a significant boost to the economy and the IT sector by equipping fresh graduates with practical experience and enhancing their employability.

#### **GDPR COMPLIANCE**

Around 40 IT & ITeS companies have been certified on ISO27001 and ISO27701 Standards, enabling them to gain access to EU and North American markets. Additionally, approximately 40 call centers have been certified on ISO18295, enhancing their operational standards and market reach.

# CERTIFICATION OF IT PROFESSIONALS

Around 5,700 IT professionals from the private and public sectors were trained and certified in emerging tools and technologies. This initiative helped companies stay competitive and enabled IT professionals to enhance their skills, contributing to the overall growth of Pakistan's IT industry.

# INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH STUDY ON "POTENTIAL OF PAKISTAN IT/ITES INDUSTRY"

PSEB and its stakeholders have set an ambitious mission to increase IT exports to USD 10 to 18 billion by 2030-31. To achieve this, sectoral objectives emphasize transforming Pakistan's IT sector into a competitive supply hub, bolstering infrastructure, refining human resource skills, and broadening the IT talent pool. The comprehensive strategy, dubbed the Revamping IT Landscape project, encompasses three strategic pillars: HR/skills development, ecosystem enhancement, and marketing. The synchronous implementation of these pillars is essential for achieving the desired impact and outcomes.

## **LOCAL EVENTS**

#### 24TH ITCN

The 24th edition of ITCN Asia, organized by E Commerce Gateway, took place at the Expo Center Lahore from April 18th – 20th,2024. Renowned as one of Pakistan's largest IT exhibitions, this three-day event served as a pivotal gathering for the nation's entire technology ecosystem. It offered a unique platform for stakeholders to converge, exchange insights, showcase innovations, and share ideas.

The event was graced by the Minister of State for IT and Telecom, Ms. Shaza Fatima, who highlighted the government's ambitions to elevate the IT industry. This year's ITCN was also attended by a delegation from the Digital Cooperation Organization (DCO), including their Secretary General, Ms. Deemah Al Yahya.

The Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) also built a TechdestiNation Pakistan Pavilion extending a 50% subsidy on stall costs to 50 eligible PSEB member companies, thereby fostering their business development and growth.

PSEB launched an initiative of forming specialized focus groups tailored to different industry verticals. These focus groups were designed to build a sense of community within the sector, providing a dynamic platform for professionals to connect, engage in meaningful discussions, and foster collaborative ventures.

To facilitate interaction and knowledge exchange, the first meet-up sessions of the BPO, Gaming & Animation and AI & IOT focus groups were held in Expo Center, Lahore during the ITCN 2024. This brought together members who shared common interests and offered a platform for networking and knowledge sharing within their respective focus groups. These sessions also enabled PSEB to gain valuable insights into the unique challenges faced by each group and their way forwards, empowering the organization to advocate for and drive resolutions with pertinent regulatory entities

# ROUNDTABLE SESSION: INNOVATE TOGETHER - UAE-PAKISTAN TECH COLLABORATIONS

To ensure impactful engagements, PSEB hired a consultant to assist companies in drafting project pitches tailored for the Saudi market, laying the foundation for successful matchmaking and collaboration.

In addition to facilitating the B2B meetings, PSEB also arranged the conference venue and provided attendees with printed industry roundups, company brochures, and promotional materials highlighting Pakistan's thriving IT industry.







#### **JAPAN IT WEEK SPRING 2024**

The Japan IT Week Spring 2024 hosted its 33rd edition from 24th-26th April at Tokyo Big Sight, offering a comprehensive showcase of the latest developments in Cloud Computing, Internet of Things (IoT), Artificial Intelligence (AI), Big Data, Security, Web and Digital Marketing, and Embedded Systems. This premier event attracted professionals, developers, system integrators, IT managers, decision-makers, and technology enthusiasts from various industries and countries. Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) facilitated four promising Pakistani companies to showcase their prowess on the global stage by attending Japan IT Week Spring 2024. The Pakistan pavilion was formally inaugurated by Pakistan's Ambassador to Japan, Mr. Raza Bashir Tarar, whose presence underscored the significance of this platform for strengthening international collaborations.







#### **GITEX Africa 2024**

GITEX Africa, the continent's largest tech event, will take place from May 29-31, 2024, in Marrakech, Morocco. This all-inclusive exhibition brings together tech titans, governments, SMEs, startups, coders, investors, and academia to accelerate innovation, foster collaboration, and explore new ventures. Covering emerging technologies such as fintech, e-commerce, cloud, IoT, AI, telecom, and cybersecurity, GITEX Africa promises to be a pivotal event.

With the African market projected to grow by 4% and on track to become the world's next significant digital economy, tech investments are expected to surge from \$115 billion to \$712 billion over the next two decades. This presents a lucrative opportunity for Pakistani IT/ITeS products and services to expand into the African market.

Building on the success of the inaugural GITEX Africa in 2023, where 10 Pakistani companies generated 600 leads and business worth USD 600K, the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) and the Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP) are offering a 60% subsidy to 17 IT/ITeS companies for participation in the 2024 edition.







#### **DUBLIN TECH SUMMIT 2024**

The Dublin Tech Summit (DTS), held at the RDS from May 29-30, 2024, gathered global leaders in innovation, technology, and business to shape the future of global trends. This summit provided an excellent platform for connecting with international colleagues and sharing industry best practices. With a focus on emerging technologies, machine learning, space exploration, big data, and analytics, DTS attracted top speakers, startups, exhibitors, sponsors, and investors.

Ireland, ranked as the fourth most attractive export destination after the USA, UK, and UAE for Pakistani IT/ITeS products and services, saw IT exports increase by over 80% from USD 100M in FY 2021-22 to USD 184M in FY 2022-23. This growth presents a remarkable opportunity for Pakistani companies to expand their footprint in the Irish market.

In collaboration with TDAP, PSEB set up a 32 sqm Pakistan Pavilion at DTS 2024, accommodating eight exhibiting companies and over 20 delegates, providing them with an invaluable opportunity to connect and network with key players in the tech industry.







#### **LONDON TECH WEEK**

Pakistan proudly presented its technological advancements under the "Tech Destination Pakistan" brand to the global tech community at London Tech Week 2024, taking place from June 10 to 14. The Tech Destination Pakistan Pavilion was inaugurated today by the High Commissioner of Pakistan to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, H.E. Dr. Mohammad Faisal. London Tech Week is a global celebration of technology, uniting the most innovative thinkers and future talent in a week-long festival.

Pakistan's participation at London Tech Week is made possible through a collaborative effort between the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), Pakistan IT industry Association (P@SHA), and the Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP). Techdestination Pakistan Pavilion showcased 9 top tier IT/ITeS companies from diverse IT verticals, highlighting cutting-edge solutions.

London Tech Week 2023 presented a timely opportunity for Pakistan to showcase its IT/ITeS companies on an international trade platform, with a particular focus on expanding business in the European market, especially in the United Kingdom, which boasts a significant share of the IT market as the world's sixth-largest economy.







#### **COLLISION CANADA**

Pakistan is proudly showcasing its technological prowess at the Collision Conference in Toronto from June 17 to 20, under the banner "Tech Destination Pakistan." The Pakistan Pavilion was officially inaugurated today by Mr. Khalil Ahmed Bajwa, Consul General of Pakistan in Toronto, and Mr. Zohaib Khan, Chairman of P@SHA.

Collision is North America's fastest-growing technology conference, attracting around 40,000 attendees annually from 117 countries. It welcomes innovators, technology professionals, companies, and investors from around the world to network and discuss the future of global technology industries.

The Tech Destination Pakistan Pavilion at Collision Conference is a collaborative effort of the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), the Pakistan IT Industry Association (P@SHA), and the Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP).

This year, in addition to participating in Collision Canada, PSEB executed extensive branding campaigns at various landmark locations across Toronto. This remarkable effort aims to redefine Pakistan's perception in Canada and establish it as a premier tech outsourcing destination. Through these multifaceted efforts, the participating companies will benefit in forging valuable connections and fostering lasting partnerships.

Chairman P@SHA Zohaib Khan highlighted the Pakistan government's initiatives in the IT sector during an insightful panel discussion titled "Government and Industry Roles in Building a Sustainable Tech Hub." #### **PAK CHINA BUSINESS CONFERENCE**

From June 4th to 7th, 2024, the Prime Minister of Pakistan, accompanied by the Minister of State for IT and Telecom, officially visited China. The visit focused on enhancing bilateral cooperation across thirteen key sectors identified for promoting trade and collaboration between the two countries, including Information Technology, Telecommunications, and Integrated Circuits (ICs). During their stay in Shenzhen, senior management from BYD and Huawei briefed the Pakistani delegation.

The Ministry of Information Technology and Telecommunication (MOITT) signed landmark agreements with Huawei to accelerate Pakistan's digital transformation journey. High-level discussions with the Chinese Minister of Industry and Information Technology reinforced support for CPEC projects and proposed deeper IT cooperation.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Pakistan Fiberization Cooperation was signed between MOITT and the Sunwalk Group. The agreement included the establishment of a joint working group to ensure the smooth implementation of the optical fiber network investment project.

The Pakistan-China Business Conference and meetings held in Shenzhen and Beijing from June 5th to 7th, 2024, marked a pivotal step forward in strengthening Pakistan-China technological collaboration. The agreements and commitments secured with leading Chinese tech enterprises and government bodies lay a robust foundation for advancing Pakistan's digital infrastructure, fostering innovation, and enhancing economic growth.
